As I read through the book of 1 Samuel, I found a passage that speaks powerfully about how we can grow in favour with God and with others, a theme echoed throughout Scripture.

The Wisdom of Growth in 1 Samuel

Reading 1 Samuel 2:36, it struck me how the young Samuel grew in favour both with the Lord and with people. The verse says, "The child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the Lord and also with men." This moment reminded me of Jesus, as described in Luke 2:40: "And the child grew and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom, and the grace of God was upon him." These verses show that we are not only meant to grow physically but also spiritually—in wisdom, maturity, and authority.
